## ■ Course Information

**Target Audience:** General officers (O-7), colonels (O-6), and/or key lieutenant colonels (O-5) selected by their commands for senior leadership responsibilities in a combined/joint special operations air component environment. This course provides strategic and operational-level education for SOF aviators and mission planners requiring comprehension of a joint special operations air component's roles, missions, and integration into multinational, joint, and conventional campaign plans/operations. This is a nominative course whereby students must apply and be accepted to attend.

**Description:** The JSOAC-CC is a two and ½ day senior professional military educational seminar designed to prepare prospective JSOAC commanders for their duties and responsibilities in a combined/joint air operations environment. The course uses presentations, discussions, and personal interaction to provide an overview of the doctrine, planning, coordination, integration, employment, and implementation of the special operations air operations strategy in combined/joint operations. Presentations by special operations senior officers and current directors/commanders from various combat headquarters will be dispersed throughout the course. Current issues and operational considerations for JSOAC commander include briefings and discussions on joint force special operations command doctrine; command and control relationships; rules of engagement and legal issues, unmanned airborne systems, space operations; risk management and safety; and JSOAC lessons learned. The course culminates with leadership perspectives from senior mentors who have served in a JSOAC, SOLE and subordinate JSOADS.

**Prerequisites/References:** Attendees must have attended the Joint Special Operations Air Component /Special Operations Liaison Element (JSOAC/SOLE) course, a separate JSOAC or SOLE course, or the new SOF Air Command and Control course (SOFAC2C). Attendees should have some experience or education in the following subjects: major contingency deployments, command ORI's, joint special operations exercises, or theater directed FTX/JTX.
