■ Course Information

Target Audience: This course is designed for Air Force Special Operations personnel filling or programmed for a position requiring knowledge of joint US special operations. The course is available to all others on a space available basis.

Description: ISOC examines the historical evolution, development, organization, and mission activities of US Special Operations Command and its components. It provides a working knowledge of Air Force special operation forces and emphasizes the joint perspective. The course uses personal accounts from elite AFSOC warriors to analyze select special operations missions. A static display familiarizes students with air and special tactics hardware and capabilities. Range Demonstration gives a visual perspective of AFSOC ground capabilities.

Course Enrollment: ISOC is an Open Enrollment course. As such, it requires no prior approval from USAFSOS faculty. Students are required to obtain a training line number (TLN) from their unit training manager. For enrolling through unit training manager (Open Enrollment link above), supply the PDS code found in the above panel, along with desired course dates to your local training manager, who will in turn reserve a course quota for you in the training system. After obtaining a TLN, students need to access and complete registration for the course through Blackboard. Please see the link below and follow the instructions.
